## SECTION 1 - BEST KEPT

• To encourage community effort and endeavour in maintaining and improving the village environment

To stimulate pride in appearance and upkeep of all public areas and buildings

**CLASSES AND PRIZES** 

Large Villages:

Less than 3,000 population Prizes - Winner and Runner-Up
Below 500 population Prizes - Winner and Runner-Up

Previous Winners' Category: Winner and runner-up, plus Dorset Echo Award to the winner of both large

and small class

Hamlets: Winner and runner-up plus Dorset Magazine Plague

First Time Entry: Prize for new village with the Judges' highest percentage mark sponsored

**WHAT WILL BE JUDGED** - Features 1 - 6 on Judging Sheet. Villages judged on a percentage mark based on the total features present in that village

## **SECTION 2 - PEOPLES' PROJECT AWARD:**

**Prizes to Winner and Runner-Up** - What makes your community special? Sing the praises of an initiative which has improved your village and is worthy of recognition and communication, village website, lunch club, neighbourhood car scheme, village archive / history etc

**SECTION 3 - Environmental Champions Award:** (Sponsored by Dorset Waste Partnership)

**Prizes to Winner and Runner-Up** - Tell us about an environmental activity which deserves recognition – no matter how big or small – we are looking for innovative projects ie green initiatives, tree or wild flower meadows, pond upkeep, care of woodlands etc

**SECTION 4 - BEST VILLAGE SHOP AWARD:** (Sponsored by Dorset Campaign to Protect Rural England) **Prizes to Winner and Runner-Up - What makes your Village / Neighbouring Village Shop (community or privately run) special?** Sing its praises, tell us how important it is to your village and therefore deserves recognition.

**SECTION 5 - COMMUNITY HERITAGE AWARD:** (Sponsored by Dorset Archaeological Committee) **Prizes to Winner and Runner-Up -** An award celebrating conventional archaeological or historic building surveys, good restorations of historic buildings or structures, new building work that is sensitive to a Conservation Area, hedge laying, local craftsmen such as masons or thatchers, community planning exercises, or just recognition of a group or individual active in community heritage.
