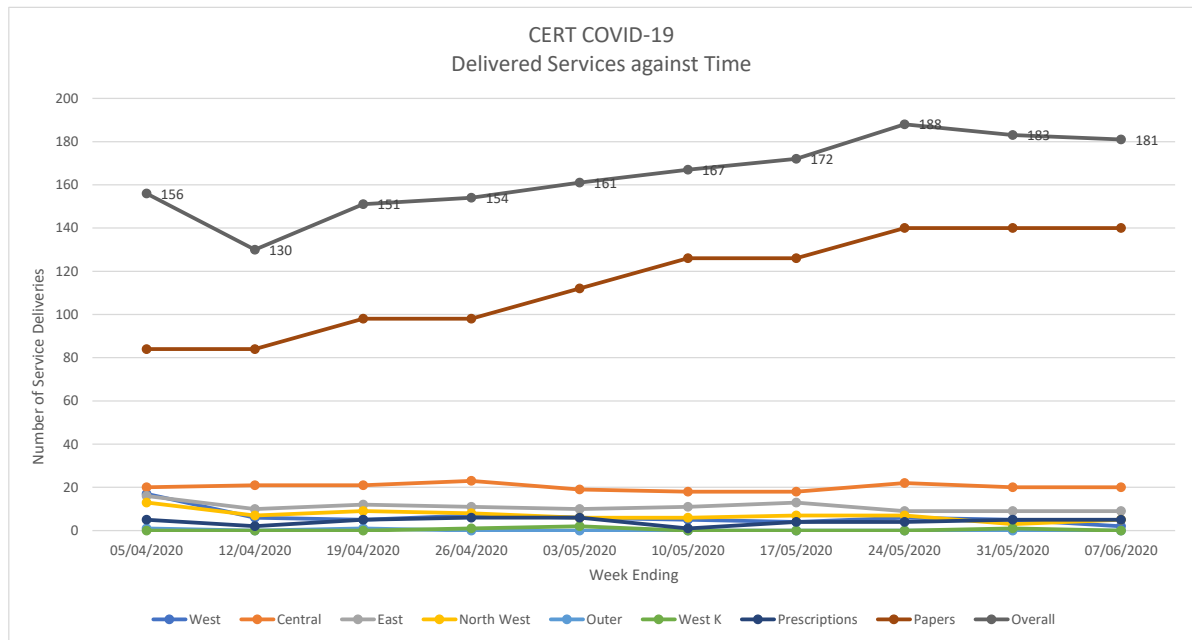
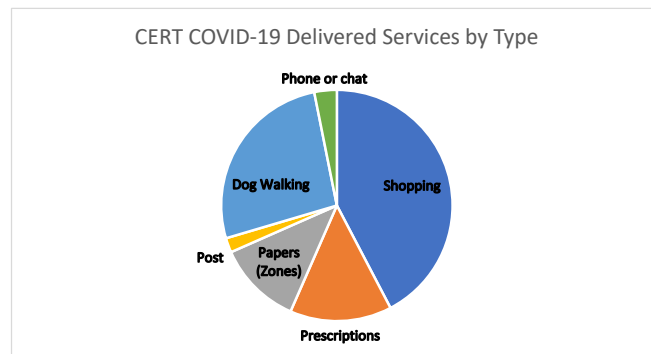


Broadmayne & West Knighton CERT Report of Service Delivery up to Sunday 7th June 2020

First graph shows delivered services, as reported to us. Much neighbour to neighbour and friend to friend support will not have been captured.
Figures now include Penny Atkins "paper round" which now involves something like 20 deliveries a day



Pie-chart is self-explanatory and covers the whole period.
It does not include the "paper round" but papers delivered by zone volunteers are included
Most dog walking is being done by one couple, in the Central zone.
All prescriptions are included, however serviced.



Final graph tries to show the average load on each Zone (Prescriptions, in this case, refers only to Kevin Denham, others are in the Zones)
Most tasks are being delivered by a small group of volunteers in each Zone so their individual load is considerably higher,
e.g. Dog Walking twice a day in Central Zone.
However the graph is a pointer to capacity. N.B. Allowance has not been made for volunteers who may not be available.
