1000	WWII convoy leaves village
1130	Festival 'opens': Living History displays (x12), Artisan Stalls, Classic Cars, children's steam train rides, children's fair games, air rifle range, food stands, WI Café, Bar, etc
1200-1245	Brass Band
1245-1315	Opening service (& WWII poems)
1315-1400	Brass Band
1410-1640	Outdoor stage: Local musicians (15-20 min each), starting with Broadmayne 1 st School performance.
1500	Wheeled mini convoy arrives and parks playing fields; convoy commander commentary on vehicles. Short interview with re-enactors.
Afternoon	Inside village hall, parallel programme of talks (history societies), plus 1940s music performance by The Land Girls for seated older members of the village.
TBC	TBC; Scruffs (conduct in neighbouring field, across the Drove. Pre-booked dogs only, with instructions that no dogs allowed on playing fields).
1640-1700	Move public to Chalky Rd, for convoy welcome
1700-1730	Line street for main armoured convoy arrival. Follow on by foot to convoy parking/camping ground (Embarkation field)
1730-1830	Viewing tanks/vehicles and interacting with re-enactors (Embarkation field)
1830	All re-enactors and public return to village hall/playing field
1900	Dinner/evening music schedule
1900-2000	The Land Girls (1940s singers)
2015-2115	Swing Band (The Saxtets – Glen Miller era)
2130-2300	Indoor DJ set
2300:	End
