- The Village Hall Trustees allowed the use of the Committee Room and heating at no charge.
- Some supplies were gifted, being remainders from other events.
- In the main, volunteers chose not to recover costs of further supplies.

- We will be paying the Village Hall for the use of the room, at a 50% discount of the Local's Rate.
- We aren't starting the season without remaindered supplies.
- We intend to reimburse volunteers for money spent.
